The Australian Government has committed to a far-reaching new public sector *Public Interest Disclosure Act*, and is currently reviewing private sector whistleblower protection under Part 9.4AAA of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth). In the United States whistleblowing laws are also being reviewed, updated and amended.
